EM works by controlling two of the four circuits of power in a cluster of workstations. When a person sits down to work, an occupancy sensor detects them and turns on the devices plugged into those two circuits—task lights, printer, computer monitor, and power brick, etc. After the person leaves, the devices automatically turn off. You can't help but start saving energy the day you install EM, and it pays for itself. It can contribute up to 10 credits toward LEED certification. EM can also provide accurate, valuable information by measuring, monitoring, and reporting energy use and workstation occupancy.
